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## Academic Goals and Targets

| Academic Goal | Target by 2012 |
| :---: | :---: |
| Reading by the end of Grade 1 | - $80 \%$ of $1^{\text {st }}$ Graders reading at or above grade level |
| Reading to learn in Grade 3 | - $100 \%$ of $3^{\text {rd }}$ Graders pass MCAS English <br> - $85 \%$ score Proficient or better <br> - Achievement gap less than 5 points |
| Skillful, analytical writing in Grades 5 and 7 | - $100 \%$ of $7^{\text {th }}$ graders attempt all open response MCAS questions <br> - Writing assignments implemented in at least 3 content areas, with performance targets on new assessments |
| Algebra 1 in Grade 8 | - $80 \%$ of $8^{\text {th }}$ Graders get B or better on final Math exam <br> - $30 \%$ of non-exam students take Algebra 1 in Grade 8 |
| "On-track" to graduate by the end of Grade 10 | - $90 \%$ of $10^{\text {th }}$ graders meet State MCAS graduation requirements |
| SAT I scores $1650+$ and Excellence for All | - All students score 1650 or better on SAT combined <br> - $100 \%$ of students take at least one AP or Honors course in high school |
| English Language Learners acquire academic language mastery and fluency | - $90 \%$ of ELLs improve two or more steps on the MEPA within the same grade, or one or more steps between grade spans, across all levels |
| College-ready and success-bound | - Annual dropout rate $3 \%$ or lower <br> - $80 \%$ four-year graduation rate <br> - $70 \%$ four-year graduation rate for ELLs and special education students |
